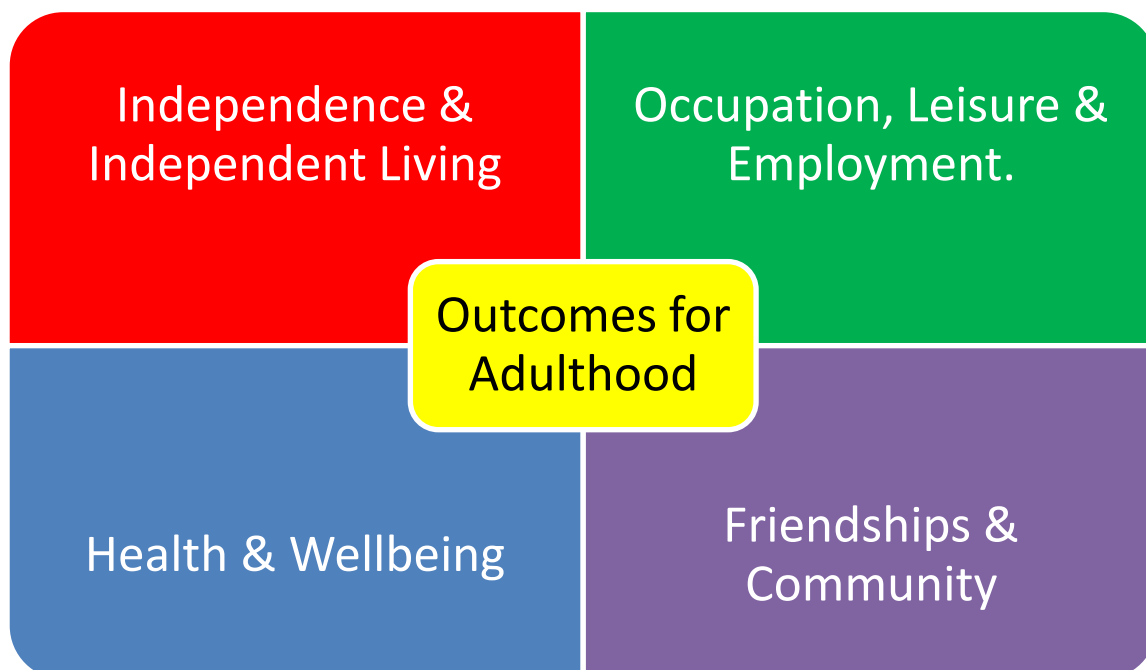

Annual Education and Out Comes for Adulthood review

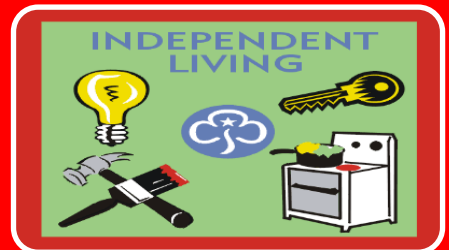
